Standards and guidelines for water efficiency are included for indoor fixtures and appliances, landscape design and irrigation systems. An independent certifier inspects each project prior to certification. At this training, you will:

- Understand the criteria for water-efficient construction.
- Complete step one toward Florida Water Star<sup>SM</sup> certifier status.
